A Message to the SCA Community

Dear SCA Parents,

The safety of our students and teachers at SCA is our first priority. As you are aware, there is a heightened awareness related to COVID-19 (the Novel Coronavirus) which we have been monitoring closely.

There are no confirmed cases reported at SCA or with anyone related to the SCA community. However, SCA also is working on contingency plans for your students in the unlikely event that our campus was to be impacted by any school closures in Maricopa County or other related outcomes due to this virus. At this time, it does not appear that this will be the case. We are committed to keeping you informed and up to date.

There are many things we can all be a part of to prevent the spread of any virus. [A letter was recently released by the Maricopa County Department of Public Health](#) with additional information that we believe is valuable information for you to have. We hope you will take the time as a family to read this. You may also consider staying up to date with the CDC's site: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/index.html>.

Because most people identified with COVID-19 have mild disease, the likelihood that the Maricopa County Department of Public Health (MCDPH) will recommend closing schools is very low. In the highly unlikely chance that MCDPH does recommend this due to a COVID-19 outbreak, it is important for parents to have a plan for who could take care of your child.

In addition, this is a good time to remind our families that students and staff should stay home if they have a fever (considered anything over 100 degrees) and should not return to campus until they have been fever-free for 24 hours without the aid of fever-reducing medication. We will keep you updated with any pressing information as it arises.
