Course Title: Minecraft Education Edition

For students entering grades 3-8 for the 2021-22 school year.

Minimum campers: 7

Maximum campers: 15 per session

Objectives: Give campers a safe, supervised place to learn and play Minecraft. This version of Minecraft, the education edition, allows the instructor to help with creative versus survival modes and allow or deny campers access to certain areas of maps. Please check with your child before registering as there are two different camps this year. Intermediate to Advanced campers should have a basic understanding of Redstone and circuits.

Campers will be able to:

- Collaborate – learn to work with other campers in completing daily mission objectives.
- Create – student from all ranges will be able to learn basic to advanced Minecraft techniques in building things as simple as a swimming pool to making a replica of the Taj Mahal.
- Challenge – students will challenge each other and be challenged by the instructor to learn more and do more.

Intermediate to Advanced Camp (see note*) - June 7-11, 2021 (1:00 pm – 5:00 pm)

Schedule: Check-in, discuss objective for the day, play Minecraft, activity break, snack break (snack items provided by camp), finish Minecraft objective(s).
