GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

SCA requires 26 credits to graduate, consisting of 4 credits of English, 4 credits of mathematics, 4 credits of Bible, 3 credits of history, 3 credits of science, 2 credits of the same world language, 1 credit of fine arts, 1 credit of computers, 1 credit of physical education, and 0.5 credit of communications.

Additional Honors Diploma Requirements: An additional academic course (either science, history, world language or mathematics), 3 credits of the same world language, 3 honors or AP courses, and 3.5 cumulative weighted GPA.
