AP Courses - GPA, grades in prior year subject area and standardized test scores considered in placement.

Honors English I & II - "A" in standard English course from prior year or "B" from Honors English course from prior year and standardized test scores will be considered.

Honors Biology - "A" in Pre-Algebra / Prior year of Math & "A" in Science 8.

Honors Algebra I & II - Placement exam & teacher recommendation

Honors Geometry - "A" in Algebra I or "B" from Honors Algebra I

ENG 101/102 - 12th grade student. 3.25 cumulative unweighted GPA.

ENH 110/111 - 11th grade student. 3.5 cumulative unweighted GPA.

SPA 101/102 - 3.0 unweighted GPA. Placement Test.

SPA 201/202 - "B" or better in SPA 101 & 102.

SPA 225/226 - "B" or better in 201/202.

MAT 114 - "A" in Algebra II or completed Pre-Calculus with a "B" or better.

HIS 110/111 - 3.5 cumulative unweighted GPA and at least a B in English I.

HIS 205/206 - 3.5 cumulative unweighted GPA and B or higher in all English and History courses.
